The Christian Aid **Lent lunches** raised **£752**.

Thank you to everyone who supported them and gave so generously.



Through 'Commitment for Life' we maintain our support for Israel and the Occupied Territory, where Christian Aid is working with the Palestinian Medical Relief Society, the Agricultural Development Association and the Palestinian Centre for Human rights, as they seek to respond to the ongoing humanitarian crisis.

'Commitment for Life' have told us that they divide donations up in this way: 75% to Christian Aid, and 5% to Global Justice Now, with 20% held to cover costs, *'though much of this money ends up being given to the work of our partners as is the case right now with Gaza'*.
